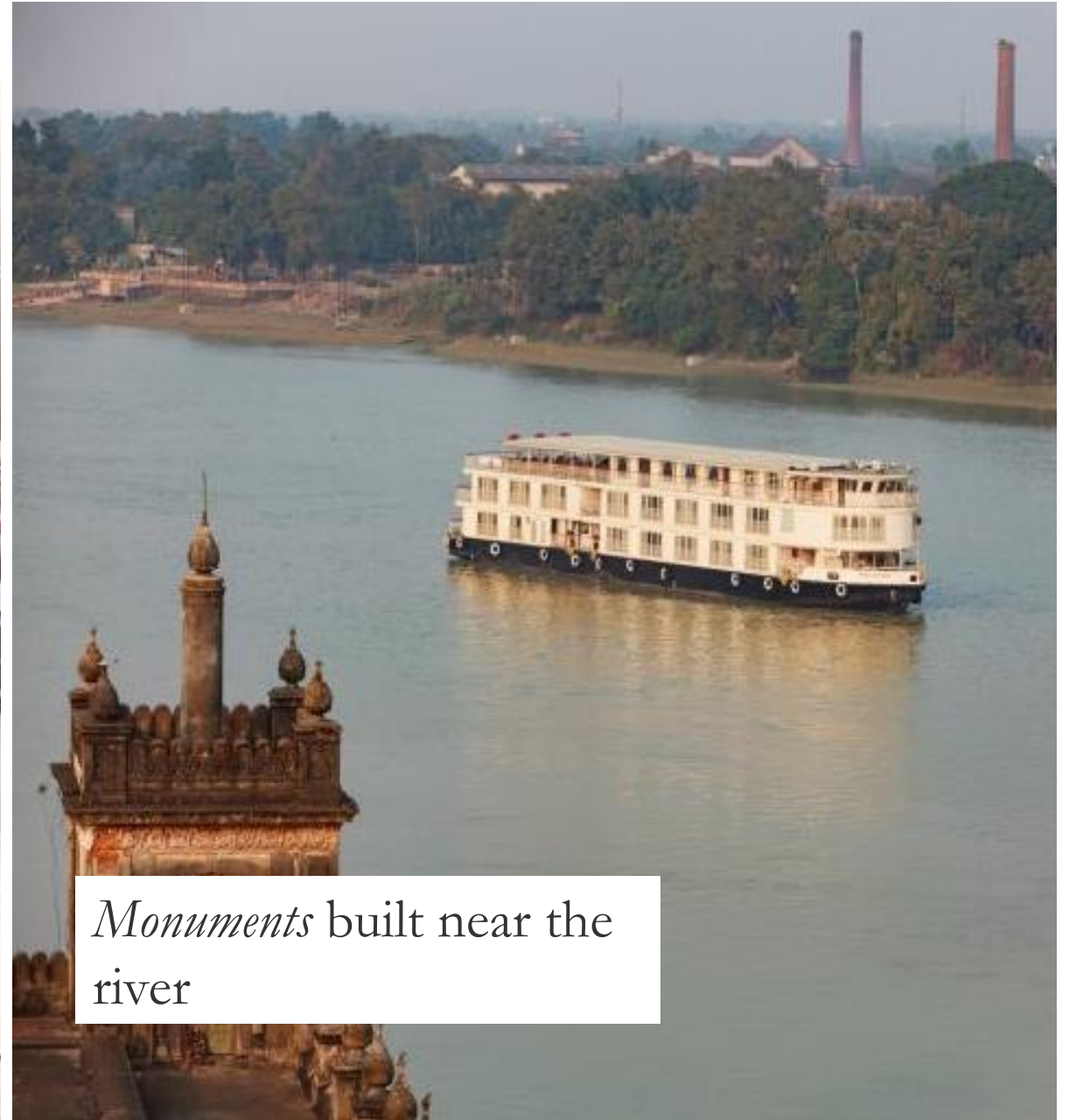

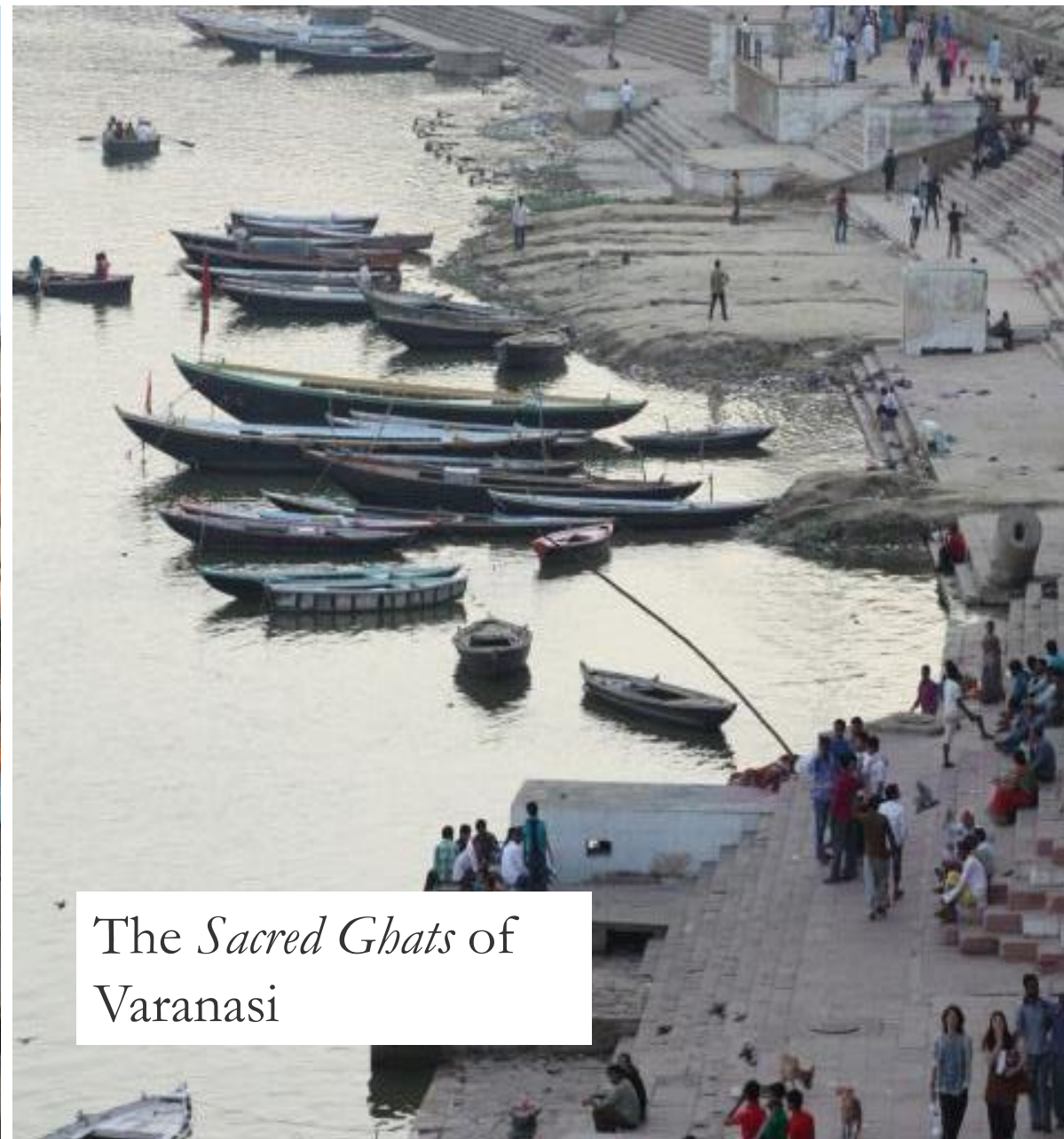

River Cruise Tourism in Saryu River, Uttar Pradesh

One of the most prominent waterways in Uttar Pradesh, the river finds mention in ancient Hindu scriptures such as the Ved and Ramayan. The river flows through Ayodhya, and as is believed, rejuvenates and washes away impurities.

Saryu riverfront has a large stretch of ghats and gardens, skirted by a row of temples. It is visited by hundreds of devotees who come here to take a holy dip throughout the year on various religious occasions.

We use Oil Separators for our Cruise Which separate's oil from bilge water to the required international standard of 15 ppm (parts per million) oil content before discharge overboard and to maintain a cleaner marine environment
