1. **Clause No 10 (o) Page No 12** of Instruction for submission of bids may be read as "Scanned copy of undertaking that the bidder will provide manufacturer's test certificate at the time of delivery of equipment at site".
2. **Clause No 3 Page No 33** of Special conditions of contract "The word 30 days may be read as 90 days".

1)	Page 12, Para 10(o) of Instruction for submission of bids	As per Clause 'G' of GCC on Page 20, equipments means copper wires, stakes, SPU, isolation transformers and associated earthing materials, please note that equipments such as copper wire and stakes do not have a brand and will be procured locally; hence, authorization certificate for the same cannot be submitted.	The tender clause will prevail. However, in case of copper wires, the bidder has to provide the manufacturer's certificate/specifications. Authorisation certificate has not been asked for in Clause 10 (a) of Instruction for submission of bids
2)	Page 26, Clause 14(ii) of General Conditions of Contract	With respect to earthing, the only test that can be performed is by using Earth Tester.	The tender clause will prevail. However, as proposed, the earthing will be tested by Earth Tester.
3)	Page 33, Clause 3 & Page 42, Clause 'd' of Special conditions of Contract	<u>Installation and delivery schedule</u> Under installation clause, it is mentioned that the installation is to be completed within 30 days of delivery. However, under clause delivery schedule, it is mentioned that the installation is to be completed within 90 days from delivery. We suggest that the installation period be 90 days from date of delivery of material.	In clause 3 Page 33, the word ' 30 days ' may be read as ' 90 days '. All other clauses remain unchanged.

4)	Page 41, Clause 13 of Special conditions of Contract & Page 5, Clause 3 of N.I.T	<u>Delivery and time of completion</u> In the clause delivery on Page 41, the time of completion is 60 days. However, since the equipments are standard and imported in nature, the OEM is manufacturing them on request or on placement of order. Hence, delivery be 90 days from the date of placement of order.	Not agreed.
5)	Page 61, Note 3 of Schedule B	<u>Road permit/Way bill</u> IWAI to provide assistance in obtaining the Way bill which is required to deliver material in Assam.	The tender clause will prevail. However, IWAI shall provide assistance to the extent possible.

1)	Page 12, Clause 10(o) of Instruction for submission of bids	<u>Scanned copy of document evidence such as manufacturer's test certificate / conformity shall be provided by bidder</u> Sir kindly alter this clause, as all the items which we are going to install come with warranty or guarantee and company who is manufacturing is solely responsible. And the manufacturing company Check, Test for quality of the product before sending in the Market.	The test certificate shall be provided by the bidder at the time of delivery of equipment. However, the scanned copy of the undertaking that the bidder will provide the manufacturer's test certificate at the time of delivery is to be submitted in the technical bid.
2)	Page 12, Clause 10(p) of Instruction for submission of bids	<u>Scanned copy of detailed technical drawing / literature/Boucher of quoted equipment etc.</u> Sir as we gone through the tender. On page, no 47 you have already given the layout drawing which we as the bidder has to follow, as per the term and condition of the tender. So therefore, you are requested to kindly alter this point.	The tender clause will prevail.

3)	Page 12, Clause 10(q) of Instruction for submission of bids	<p><u>Scanned copy of comparative statement -Bidder has to clearly mentioned the name of manufacturer (OEM), Model no of quoted item, quoted item specification vis-à-vis specification of item mentioned in this tender document</u></p> <p>Sir as on today we are sitting in a competition market, so many brands are available here and many options are available, so if we put only single OEM name and not get the items which we have to install, we have to choose another OEM who is making same items. So therefore, you are requested to kindly alter this point. It will be as per availability of the item conforming to relevant IS Standard.</p>	The tender clause will prevail. However, the bidder may have the option to propose the equipment of maximum 3 manufacturers for procurement during installation, depending upon the availability in the market.
