

Information regarding the Trans-loading point in the coast of Odisha

A meeting was held on 30th July 2013 at Delhi in the Ministry of Shipping, wherein interalia following points were discussed and agreed upon regarding the trans-loading point on the coast of State of Odisha

- (1) Kolkata Port carries out the trans-loading operations at Sandheads but on account of inclement weather conditions, trans-loading operations can be carried out at this location only for 7 months in a year. Hence an alternative location i.e. 2 nautical miles radius around the point 21° 08' 12" N/ 87 ° 14 ' 00" E is identified where trans-loading operations could also take place.
- (2) The above location shall be notified as part of Paradip Port Trust.
- (3) The location 21° 08' 12" N/ 87 ° 14 ' 00" E may be used for carrying out the trans-loading operation for NTPC coal.

Bidders are advised to do their own due diligence with regard to above location
