However, to participate in the tender, bidder has to pay a non-refundable fee of Rs. 6000/-. The method of payment will be Demand Draft, to be submitted along with the bid. - 6. For submission of the bid, the bidder is required to have Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from one of the Certifying Authorities authorised by Government of India for issuing DSC.
