The Inland Waterways Authority of India is an autonomous body constituted by the Act of Parliament, Inland Waterways Authority of India Act, 1985 (82 of 1985) under Ministry of Shipping, Government of India, for regulation, development & maintenance of National Waterways.

For Project Management Unit a Sr. Consultant (Marine) is required for which the Eligibility/ Conditions and Duties:-

Eligibility/ Condition/ Duties:-

- Post** - Sr. Consultant (Marine)
- Duration** - Initially for period of One year with provision for extension for another two years on mutually agreeable Terms and Conditions.

Educational & Professional Qualifications:

- Degree in Marine Engineering / Competency certificate of Chief Officer and above from a recognized University/Institute or equivalent.
- 15 years' experience as an officer on board Merchant ships/coastal vessels.
- Desirable: - Captain on Board Merchant Ship for more than 5 years and worked as Head of operations at shore establishment.

Age: - Maximum 50 years.

Remuneration: - Rs. 1,20,000/- per month

Duties and responsibilities:

- i. Planning and transportation of cargo between origin and destination.
- ii. Planning movement of all barges and Tugs.
- iii. Proper loading and carriage of goods on barges.
- iv. Interaction with stakeholders of industries and business communities.

- v. Obtain permissions for smooth flow of vessel transportation and similar requirements.
- vi. Ensure timely movement of vessels and achieving set targets with available resources.
- vii. Planning of ships, calling for transshipment operation.
- viii. Bunkering all vessels as well as chartered vessels and development of data bank for barges.
- ix. Liaison with Customs, CHA, Local Agents and State IWTs.
- x. Any other work assigned by Member (Traffic).

The Marine Captain / Marine Consultant will be based at Kolkata reporting to Director, Kolkata and will look after the work on all National Waterways. He will have to attend IWAI HQrs, Noida, as and when required. The cost of the first trip to Noida in the month will have to be borne by the Consultant. IWAI will pay for the second and subsequent trips, if any during the month, as per the entitlement.
